



## Scholarships for Hispanic/Latino Students

### Hispanic Scholarship Fund ([www.hsf.net](http://www.hsf.net))

- Available to high school, college, and community college transfer students
- Offers a variety of scholarships
- Check website for details and deadlines about each scholarship

### Hispanic College Fund ([www.hispanicfund.org](http://www.hispanicfund.org))

- Awarded more than \$3 billion to almost 600 students
- Offers a variety of scholarships for students studying business, math, technology, science or engineering
- Check website for the individual deadline

### Chicana/Latina Foundation ([www.chicanalatina.org](http://www.chicanalatina.org))

- Offers merit based scholarships to 30 Chicana/Latina women, valued at \$1500
- Deadline in March

### Congressional Hispanic Caucus Institute ([www.chci.org](http://www.chci.org))

- Funds one-time scholarship of \$2,500 to attend a 4-year academic institution or \$1,000 to attend a 2 year community college or AA/AS granting institution
- Students must demonstrate financial need, strong writing skills, consistent and active participation in public/community service activities, full-time enrollment, US citizenship or legal permanent residency
- Deadline April 16, 2011

### Hispanic Association of Colleges and Universities ([www.hacu.net](http://www.hacu.net))

- Awards a variety of scholarships
- Deadlines and award amounts vary
- Recipients must attend a HACU-member institution

**Hispanic Heritage Awards Foundations ([www.hispanicheritage.org](http://www.hispanicheritage.org))**

- Open to graduating high school seniors who maintain an un-weighted 3.0 GPA
- Award categories include academic excellence, business, education (future teachers), engineering and mathematics, journalism, leadership, and sports
- More categories are added each year and are subject to change without notice

**First in My Family Scholarship ([www.thesalliemaefund.org](http://www.thesalliemaefund.org))**

- Open to Hispanic Americans who are the first in their family to attend college and who demonstrate financial need
- Awards range from \$500 - \$5,000

**Gates Millennium Scholars ([www.gmsp.org](http://www.gmsp.org))**

- Scholarship for minority students who meet the Pell Grant eligibility criteria and have a minimum 3.3 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- Meet the Federal Pell Grant eligibility criteria
- Students must be nominated by an educator familiar with the student's work

**Questbridge ([www.questbridge.org](http://www.questbridge.org))**

- Connects bright, motivated, low-income students with education and scholarship opportunities at 27 partnering colleges & universities
- Over 1,000 students received admission and grant money to attend these universities
