

## **Scholarships due in April**

### **California Wine Grape Growers Foundation Scholarship**

Applicants must have a parent who was/is employed as a vineyard employee of a wine grape grower during the 2012 or 2013 wine grape-growing season. Students who have a parent who is a wine grape grower may request a waiver from the eligibility requirement based on financial need. There are two separate scholarship programs. One is for students planning to attend a University of California or California State University campus (\$1000.00 per year for four years). The other is for students planning to attend a California Community College (\$500.00 per year for two years). To remain eligible for the scholarship, you must maintain satisfactory grades in at least 12 units per semester.

Scholarship recipients are selected on a combination of financial need, demonstrated academic achievement, community involvement, leadership, and/or work history, determination to succeed, and a 500 word essay.

### **California Wine Grape Growers Foundation Robert Miller Scholarship for Viticulture and Enology**

Applicants may not be children of current directors or employees of the California Wine Grape Growers Foundation. Applicants must be a Central Coast high school senior graduating in 2013. Plan to major in viticulture or enology at Alan Hancock community College or Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo. To remain eligible for the scholarship, you must maintain satisfactory grades in at least 12 units per semester. Scholarship recipients are selected on a combination of financial need, demonstrated academic achievement, community involvement, leadership, and/or work history, determination to succeed, and a 500 word essay.
